# GUIDE LINE

## INTRODUCTION

Welcome to our studio!

Thank you for choosing to guest with us. We love meeting new artists and providing a professional and comfortable space to work.

This guideline will help you get oriented with how things run in our studio. It's here to make sure your time here is smooth, safe, and aligned with our studio standards.



## Time schedule

Reception hours:  
Mon, Wed, Fri: 11:00 – 16:00



Please plan your arrival and departure during these hours so we can show you around the studio, give you time to bring in your personal belongings, and answer any questions you may have. Arrivals and departures at different days or times are possible only after prior agreement with the management.

You are welcome to schedule your clients throughout the week, including weekends, ideally between 10:00 – 19:00.

Studio keys are available upon prior agreement.

## Supplies

At the beginning of each day, you will be assigned a workstation with a small table and basic consumables. Additional consumables can be found in the large supply cabinet (inks, needles, cups).

More information about materials is available on a separate card.

## Informed consent

The tattoo consent form is available on the reception desk in both Czech and English. Please make sure it is filled in and signed with your client before the tattoo session. If reception is present, the receptionist will take care of this.



## Refreshments

In the kitchen you will find juices, tap drinking water, and tea available for you and your clients.

We recommend offering clients water during their tattoo session to help them stay hydrated.

A coffee machine and milk (regular and oat) are also available and free to use.

You will also find complimentary candies at the reception for both you and your clients.

## Aftercare



Available for clients at the reception with the price list. If the reception is unattended, the tattoo artist can use the QR code for payment, or the client can pay in cash.

## Protective Equipment



The studio uses aseptic nitrile gloves.

Please be careful to avoid cross-contamination and do not place unwrapped items on the workstation or tattoo chair.

If gloves come into contact with a contaminated surface, please avoid touching lights or unwrapped parts of the armrest with them.

Use as many gloves as you need.

Face masks, hair bands and hair nets are also available.

## Studio Hygiene

The aim of this guideline is to maintain a high standard of quality and safety.

## Shoes

Please change your shoes upon entering the tattoo studio.



Slippers or disposable shoe covers are available at the reception. We kindly ask that you respect this rule and offer slippers to your clients as well.

Guests may bring their own slippers and store them in the shoe cabinet in the kitchen.

## Waste



Trash bags should be taken out to the courtyard through the passageway.

Keys to the entrance can be borrowed from the reception. If the reception is unattended, please keep the trash hidden behind the reception area or in the kitchen.

Recyclables (paper, plastic, and glass) can be found in the kitchen under the sink.

An additional paper bin is located under the printer.

## Chairs and Armrests

Armrests and chairs must be covered with stretch film or protective covers.

After each tattoo, please remove the covers and disinfect the surfaces.



## Pillows and Blankets

For clients, pillows and blankets are available for added comfort.

Pillows are washable, but we still cover them with film.

Please keep blankets at a safe distance from the tattooed area.



## Printer

A thermal copier and printer are available, connected via the studio Wi-Fi.

Wi-Fi password can be scanned via a QR code in our shop.

# TATTOO SUPPLIES

## Workstation supplies

Upon arrival, you will be assigned a guest workstation containing the following materials:

- A pack of gloves (please do not leave it open; store in a bag)
- Spray bottle with antibacterial soap
- Spray bottle with hand sanitizer
- Spray bottle with surface and tool disinfectant
- Container with grip tape
- Container with cups of various sizes
- Manicure mats for the workstation (please wrap in a bag)
- Plastic bags
- Trash bags

## Shared studio supplies

Other shared studio materials can be found in the large black cabinet, specifically:

- Spatulas
  - Cups
  - Machine covers
  - Disposable razors
  - Second Skin
  - Stencil liquid
  - After tattoo spray
  - After tattoo foam
  - Small cups
  - Distilled water
  - Film (stretch/cling wrap)
  - Chair covers
  - Wipes (boxes on the left)
  - Barrel for used needles
  - Paper (under the stencil printer)
- Inks:
- Black ink – Dynamic
  - White ink – Kuro Sumi
  - Other colors – Kuro Sumi / WF, depending on current stock
- Cartridges:  
Bishop, Kwadron, Mast...
- 3RL (04, 06, 08, 10)
  - 5RL, 7RL, 9RL, 18RL
  - 5RS, 9RS, 18RS
  - 7M, 13M, 23M  
(occasionally other sizes as well)

# TATTOO SUPPLIES

## IMPORTANT

*Use materials from your GUEST station + the cabinet. PLEASE do not take anything from other tattoo artists' workstations – these are personal belongings, and any removal of others' items must be reimbursed.*

## Can't find something?

It happens – things sometimes get misplaced.

Don't hesitate to ask anyone in the studio or at reception.

Our tattoo artists and reception staff will be happy to help you.

Alternatively, you can contact management directly – see the phone number in the contacts. We're here for you! :)

## Something is not working?

Equipment such as lights, armrests, chairs, and others naturally wear over time, and occasionally things may break or get damaged.

Please inform management of any issues so we can address them and ensure work can continue smoothly for all artists.

Don't worry – as long as it's not due to your direct negligent handling, no penalties will be applied.
